

Who is Fried Strolenberg ?

Godfried E.C.M. Strolenberg was born at the Fourth of July 1947 in Kerkrade, the Netherlands. After his elementary and secondary school and his army service, he studied biology at the University of Nijmegen NL from 1968. He finished this study in 1974



(specialization in plant physiology especially photosynthesis). In 1973 he also taught biology at the Sancta Maria College and the Gymnasium Rolduc in Kerkrade NL.

From 1974 up to 1979 he worked at the University of Nijmegen NL. In 1979 he made his doctor in science (PhD) with investigations on the neurosecretory system of the crayfish. For publications google G.E.C.M.Strolenberg.

During this period he participated in investigations at the Laboratoire de Biologie Marine at Concarneau (Bretagne), France, for two periods of six months.

After this he taught biology for three months at the Eykhagen College in Landgraaf NL. From April 1980 up to September 2010 he was employed as biology teacher at the Stella Maris College at Meerssen NL.

From 1982 to 1987 he also was a tour guide for travels to Africa, especially for Kenya and Tanzania. Some stories of that period you will find here.
